<b>Using CAPP- Area Prerequisites</b> Are you tired of the tedious and often error-prone system of maintaining your prerequisites? Having to set them up or modify them at the catalog level only to then have to ask ITS to run SQL scripts to make sure your prerequisites hit all sections of the course for each required semester? More than two years ago, the Community College of Philadelphia converted from the generic prerequisite system to one using CAPP-Area prerequisites. Although we have a fairly complex prerequisite system, the CAPP-Area method has worked like a charm and dramatically reduced our maintenance time and effort. In addition, you do not need to have the Banner CAPP module up and running to use this method. So, come and see what your institution can do to make managing prerequisites more manageable.
