On-Line Graduation Application and Manual Roll for Banner 8.x This fall, Villanova implemented Banner 8.0 Self Service Graduation Applications to streamline graduation processing for May 2010 graduates. These new procedures and self service pages reduce the collection of paper forms and extensive data entry used to determine the graduating class and diploma production. The new grade roll functionality also reduced data entry and allowed us to defer the creation of degree records until time of graduation rather than at each grade roll, decreasing the creation of unnecessary "sought" records. We will demonstrate the use of baseline self-service pages, set-up requirements and explanation of the manual grade roll process.
